The theme and style of your décor dictates the atmosphere of your function, keeping in mind that the colours should compliment rather than clash with your venue. Let your imagination flow...



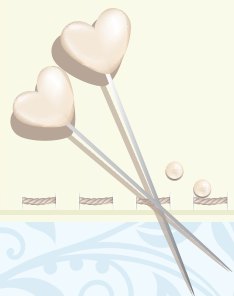

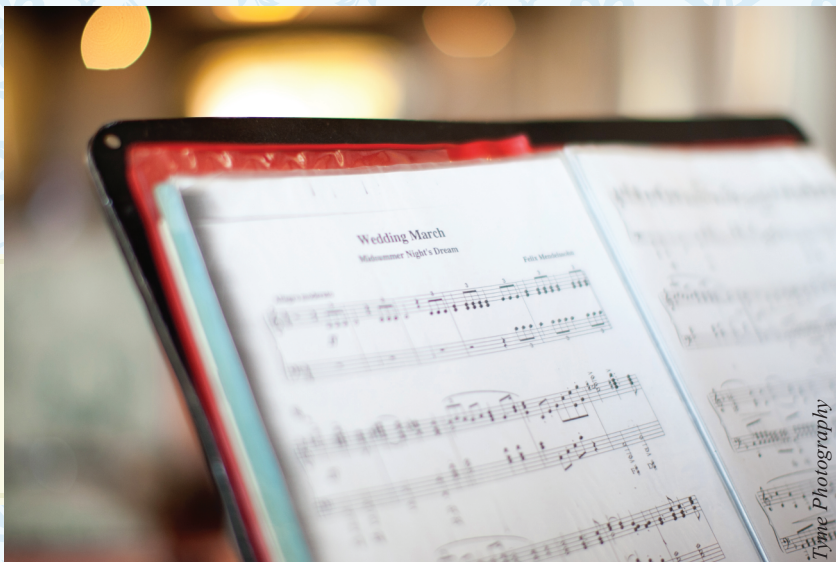
